5-Year Breakup Plan for Dayanand Vedic College, Orai (2023-2028)

The following plan outlines the phased implementation of the Perspective Plan (2023-2028) across seven NAAC criteria. Each year focuses on specific goals to ensure systematic progress toward institutional excellence.

Year 1 (2023-2024): Foundation and Infrastructure Development

Focus Areas: Infrastructure, Curriculum, and Basic Systems

- Infrastructure & Learning Resources (Criteria 4)**
 - Upgrade computer labs with modern hardware/software.
 - Initiate Wi-Fi installation across the campus.
 - Begin construction/renovation of classrooms and labs.
 - Procure e-learning resources (MOOCs, SWAYAM, e-books).
- Curricular Aspects (Criteria 1)**
 - Increase student intake capacity for existing courses.
 - Introduce 2-3 skill-oriented short-term courses.
 - Conduct faculty training for NEP 2020 implementation.
- Teaching-Learning (Criteria 2)**
 - Train faculty on ICT tools for teaching.
 - Launch online student feedback system for teachers.
- Student Support (Criteria 5)**
 - Organize 1-2 industrial visits and soft skill workshops.
 - Strengthen the Placement Cell with industry tie-ups.
- Institutional Values (Criteria 7)**
 - Initiate plastic-free campus drives.
 - Install solar panels and LED lighting in key areas.

Year 2 (2024-2025): Capacity Building and Quality Enhancement

Focus Areas: Faculty Development, Research, and Student-Centric Practices

- Teaching-Learning (Criteria 2)**
 - Implement student-centric teaching methods (flipped classrooms, LMS).
 - Define Programme Outcomes (POs) and Course Outcomes (COs).
- Research & Extension (Criteria 3)**
 - Organize 1 national seminar on research/IPR.
 - Motivate faculty to publish 5+ papers in ISSN/ISBN journals.
 - Sign 2-3 MoUs with industries/NGOs.
- Governance (Criteria 6)**
 - Conduct internal audits and staff welfare programs.
 - Formalize annual performance appraisal for staff.
- Infrastructure (Criteria 4)**
 - Complete Wi-Fi coverage and gymnasium upgrades.
 - Enrich library with NEP-aligned books/journals.
- Student Support (Criteria 5)**
 - Launch remedial classes for competitive exams (UGC NET/Civil Services).
 - Establish active alumni association.

Year 3 (2025-2026): Research and Community Engagement

Focus Areas: Research, Outreach, and Sustainability

- Host an international conference.
- Secure 1-2 government-sponsored research projects.
- Train students in workshops for job readiness.

2. Institutional Values (Criteria 7)

- Conduct energy/gender/environment audits.
- Awareness campaigns on water conservation/voting rights.

3. Student Support (Criteria 5)

- Expand career counseling and sports facilities.
- Alumni-funded scholarships for needy students.

4. Curriculum (Criteria 1)

- Introduce diploma courses in emerging fields.
- Faculty participation in university-level curriculum design.

Year 4 (2026-2027): Excellence and Automation

Focus Areas: Automation, Academic Excellence, and Industry Collaboration

1. Infrastructure (Criteria 4)

- Complete auditorium construction.
- Automate library systems (RFID, digital cataloguing).

2. Teaching-Learning (Criteria 2)

- 100% faculty adoption of ICT tools.
- Social responsibility projects (NSS/NCC-led initiatives).

3. Governance (Criteria 6)

- State/national seminars on leadership.
- Strengthen stakeholder communication of vision/mission.

4. Research (Criteria 3)

- 10+ faculty members guiding PhD students.
- Consultancy projects for local community upliftment.

Year 5 (2027-2028): Consolidation and Accreditation Readiness

Focus Areas: Sustainability, Accreditation, and Holistic Growth

4. Research (Criteria 3)

- 20+ research publications/year.
